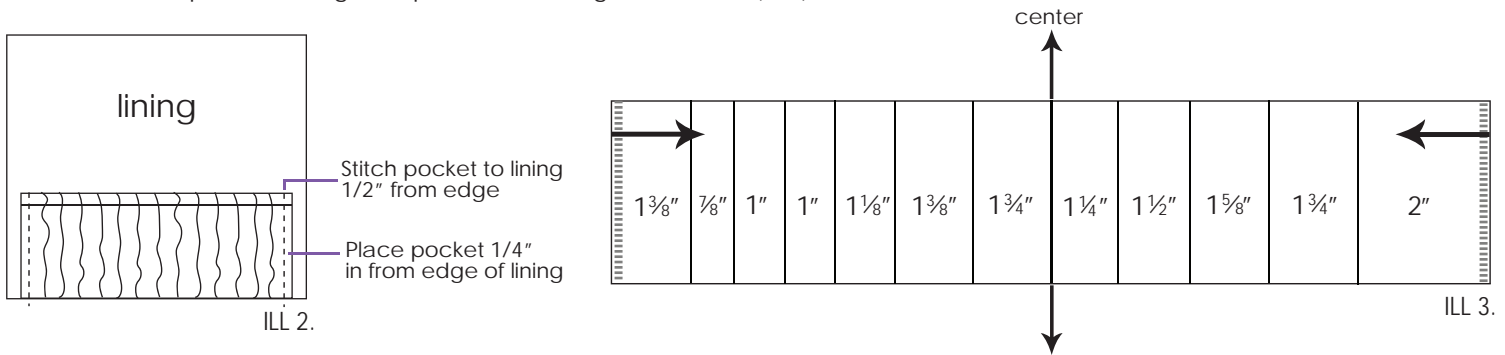


SEWING DIRECTIONS FOR BASIC CASE: (continued from previous page)

- Place the pocket on the lining (8 7/8" x 16 7/8") 1/4" in from the outside edge. Stitch pocket sides to the lining 1/2" from the edge. (Ill. 2)
- Adjust gather. Measure the sections of the needle pocket following the diagram. Draw the placement lines using a water soluble blue marker. Top stitch through the pocket and lining on the lines. (Ill. 3)

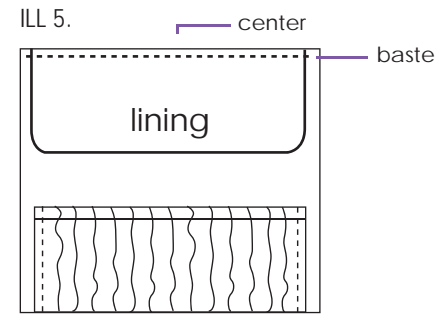
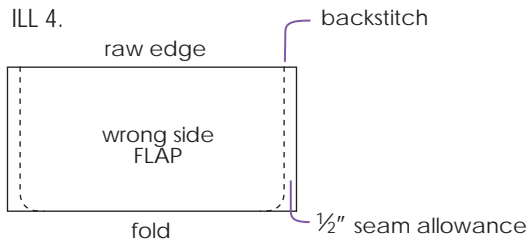


Flap: 7" x 16 1/2"

- Fold the rectangle in half across the length right sides together.
- Mark a gradual curve on each corner 1/2" in from the raw edge ends to the fold. Stitch on the seam allowance and curve, back stitching at the beginning and end. Turn and press. (Ill. 4)
- Center the raw edges of the flap on the top of the lining. Baste. (Ill. 5)

NOTE:

The lining is now ready to be sewn to the cover. If you choose to embellish the cover now is the time to do this work.



INSTRUCTIONS FOR EMBELLISHMENTS:

Version #1: Rosettes

Make a small and medium rosette following the instruction for advanced rosette making. The seam will be on the inside of the rose. Make one large leaf and two small leaves. You can use ribbon to make the leaves or Dupioni Silk. Follow the illustration for making the leaves. Sew the roses and leaves in place as in the photo.

Version #2 Pansies

Make two pansies and two leaves using the mold. All instructions are included in the package. Needle felt the pansies, leaves and vine directly into the felt cover on the right side following the photograph on the right.

Version #3 Socks

Transfer the design onto Weaver's Cloth or directly onto the wrong side of the cover (suggest a tightly woven fabric). The design is worked on the wrong side of the fabric. Complete instructions for needle punch are included in the packaging. If you used weaver's cloth cut 1" beyond the design, press the fabric to the back and appliqué the design to the cover.



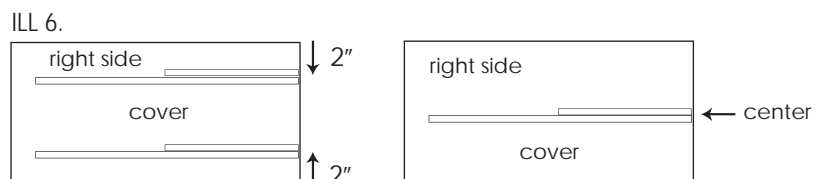
NEEDLE CASE ASSEMBLY:

Step 1: For the ribbon closure:

2 Ribbons: Measure 2" in on each side. Fold 2 pieces of 24" ribbon at the 1/3 mark (8") and pin to the right side of the cover at both markings.
1 Ribbon: Measure the center. Fold and pin the ribbon to the center mark just as illustrated. (Ill. 6)

Step 2: With right sides together sew the cover to the lining using a 1/2" seam allowance. Leave a 6" opening at the center base of the case. Turn and stitch the opening closed.

Congratulations! Get those needles in the case! It's a wrap!
